2. ANDREW² PECK (*ANDREAS¹ BECK*) was born Bef. 1740 in Germany, and died November 1822 in Augusta Co., Va.. He married ANNA WEBER January 15, 1760 in Donegal and Hanorer, York Co., Pennsylvania.

Notes for ANDREW PECK:

Probably Andreas Beck of Ebingen, Wuerttemberg, born 11-4-1740, son of Andreas, who sailed with Jacob Beck and Johann Bernhard Beck, in ship Edinburg, Sep 14 1753, arrived in Philadelphia, and Christina Dorothea Keimmel.

Andreas jr married Catharina Bucher Jul 30 1758, by Rev Heinselman, At Augustus Lutheran Church, Trapp PA. Bernhard also had a son Andreas b.11 30 1738 (Yoder, Penn. German Immigrants 1709-1786, pg 36)

This is likely his son as our Andreas m. Anna Weber in 1760 although some sources believe he came on the Loyal Judith.

I was able to find a christening record for a Daniel Beck, whose parents were Andreas and Anna Beck.

Daniel Beck was christened 9 October 1776 at the Frederick Evangelical Lutheran Church, Frederick County, Maryland, the son of Andreas and Anna Beck according to IGI records located on the LDS site.

Further research revealed a marriage in the Rev. John Cooper Stoever's '1429' marriage records. Records of Baptisms and Marriages by Rev. Johan Stoever for York County, Pennsylvania, 1730-1779

Andreas Beck (Donegal) and Anna Weber (Hanover) 1760, January 15th which coincides with the time frame we are seeking.

In 1788, we find Andrew Beck's name in Augusta County, Virginia in Chalkley's Chronicles of the Scots-Irish.

Early records show the name as Peck, but later census records show Beck. The name Beck was used consistently by Andrew's grandson David Beck after coming to Iowa

Was a soldier in the Revolutionary War. His parents are believed to be Andrew (Andreas) Beck and Anna Beck-- Andreas Beck and his family came to America from Germany on the "Loyal Judith" in 1740. He was 30 years old according to ship records.

Jacob Peck deposes, 1821, he came to Staunton in 1771, August. On that part of lot 5 now occupied by Dr. Waddell, there were no improvements in 1771. The stables that lately stood thereon were built in fall of 1772. The rental after 1786 was about \$5 per annum. In 1773-4 Thomas Smith offered to sell the lot on which Mr. Wayt's stone house and the adjoining white house now stands for £10 and could not get it. He afterwards made a present of it to a young lady.

"Lived on the James River, near Staunton, VA--was a blacksmith by trade, but lived on a farm, raised stock, made wool flax, dried fruit, made butter and cheese, and owned a still-house. His home was a very pretentious one."

Sons Andrew, Daniel & John possibly went to Tippecanoe co IN by 1840. Daniel bought the land his father owned after his fathers death. Will was dated Dec 10 1830, and was filed March term 1831, book 17 pg 500, witnessed by Wm Clayton, Virghart? Montgomery & Nancy Peck. the only child mentioned by name was Andrew, as executor. Final settlement bk 30 pg 271, Aug 26 1850, mentions widow Elizabeth, John, Andrew , Jacob , David, Daniel, William Beck, George Dorsey or Douglas & wife, George Harness & wife, Ralph Black & wife, Washington Gwin & wife. daughters Julia, Elizabeth & Nancy not mentioned? (needs rechecked)

1832 land was sold by David Summers (executor), Andrew Beck & Elizabeth Beck to Jacob Peck (Beck) item just before the sale is Enos & Eliz. Silling to John Henderson.

1810 census has Daniel with 5 males under 10, 1 26-45, females 2 under 5, 1 10-16 1 26-45
St Johns German Reformed Church registers, Middlebrook Augusta Co Virginia, lists Daniel as a communicant in 1806,& 1818, and mentions Anna, Andrew, Julianna, William, & Drusilla's baptisms.
