

Descendants of Lorenzo Dow Inskeep

Generation No. 1

1. Lorenzo Dow¹ Inskeep was born 1836, and died June 15, 1864 in Bur. Arlington Cemetery. He married **Rebecca Jeffries** 1858¹, daughter of Joseph Jeffries and Sarah Mullen. She was born June 01, 1840 in Pennsylvania, and died April 24, 1921 in Belmont County, Flushing, Ohio.

Notes for Lorenzo Dow Inskeep:

Lorenzo Dow Inskeep was very patriotic and with war clouds hovering, took a band to recruit volunteers, and formed a unit in the township "Co. E -- 122 Regiment, Ohio Volunteers" He enlisted for three years and "or duration of the war". He was mustered in a corporal on October 3, 1862, Zanesville, Ohio. Later he became a sergeant.

At Cold Harbor, the bloodiest battle was fought. Their loss was 12,000 men in less than one hour. L. D. Inskeep was shot in the corner of his right eye, the ball passing through his neck, coming out his back. He was taken to General Lee's home, renamed "Lincoln Hospital", where he died two weeks later on June 15, 1864
