

## *Descendants of John FREELAND*

### *Generation No. 1*

**1. John<sup>1</sup> FREELAND** was born Jun 1780 in Freeland, Baltimore Co, Maryland, and died 19 Dec 1873 in Preston Co., West Virginia. He married **Mary MCCANN** 1804, daughter of John MCCANN and Jane EYERSON. She was born Abt. 1783 in Fayette Co., Pa., and died Apr 1872 in Preston County, West Virginia.

Notes for John FREELAND:

Morton's History of Preston County on pg 350 says: John Freeland came about 1804 from Pennsylvania, or from near Baltimore. He settled near St. Joe, but his sons, David, Benjamin, Aaron, and Hiram located in the vicinity of Terra Alta, and James on Nettle Ridge. David was a great huntsman and is said to have killed 600 deer.

William B. is a veteran teacher, especially of his home school, and has been in the State Legislature. Frank, the son of David, is a physician in New York.

From This Green Glade by Jo Ann Sereno Teets, pg 3: About 1791, another early settler came to Cranberry Summit. He was John Freeland from Baltimore who married Polly McCann of Fayette County, Pennsylvania. he had two sons, David and Benjamin. John lived to an age of 94, dying in 1873. David was born in 1809 and gained local fame as a hunter. He is said to have killed 600 deer in his lifetime. Twice he supposedly killed five deer in one day. (Wiley, pg 45) John settled in the area known now as Freeland Settlement and is the founder of the clan by that name.

Who was John Freeland's father? Did they follow the custom of naming the eldest son after the paternal father? If so, James Freeland might be a candidate for the predecessor since we know John Freeland was born in Maryland.

John FREELAND, Preston Co., West Virginia: I, John FREELAND, of the county of Preston, State of West Virginia do make and publish this as my last Will and Testament after my death. First, I direct the payment of my debts out of my personal estate, Second, I give and bequeath to Polly FREELAND my wife in case she should outlive me for her support during her life and at her death then and thereafter to be the property of David FREELAND, my son and my wife Polly's support, as above mentioned. I assigned the one third of my property, personal and real and I give and bequeath to James FREELAND, Aaron FREELAND, Hiram FREELAND, Abram FREELAND, George FREELAND, Rachel SNIDER, and Elizabeth HARDESTY, my children, one dollar each. Third, I give and bequeath for the support of William, Isaac and Jacob FREELAND, my three invalid boys, the residue of my property, both personal and real and I hereby appoint my son David FREELAND, my executor to act in my stead and for me as if I was living to execute the provisions of this my last will and testament, and after the death of the three boys, William, Isaac, and Jacob FREELAND, my sons, then and thereafter the property of my son, David FREELAND. And I hereby further declare and constitute my son David and empower him to act and do for the three boys, William, Isaac and Jacob FREELAND, my children as in his judgment seems best for their support and comfort. Confiding in him for the care and comfort of the three boys. In witness whereof I hereby set my hand and seal in my hand as and for my last will and testament of Portland Township, Preston Co, W. Va. this the 7th day of January A.D., 1873.

Photos from Brian Bishoff and his description of the burial grounds.

His note: The woods where her grave is located is actually right on the border of some hundreds of acres of land owned/leased by the Army for training purposes. The boundary marker is on a large tree right next to Rachel's grave, so I am not sure exactly who owns the land that the grave is sitting on. I am in the Army Reserve and my unit is located at Camp DAWSON (Kingwood, WV) so I train often on that training site..(My unit is actually training there as we speak.) I heard through the grapevine that there were some grave sites on that mountain so I did some asking around and found out exactly where they were. (There are at least three gravesites there that I know of, but Rachel's is the only one bearing the name Snider.) Do not worry about the graves being damaged by soldiers or equipment; actually the opposite is true. Much care is taken by the Natural Resources Dept. at Camp DAWSON to ensure that the land, trees, wildlife, etc. on the Pringle Training Area is not disturbed. (Pringle Training Area is named for Pringle Run; a stream that runs through the area down the mountain toward Cheat River.)

Rachel's grave is at the very top of the mountain and overlooks the Cheat River Valley. It is a very pretty and serene site, even after 157 years. I would be more than happy to take some photos of the grave site and of the surrounding area for you. My wife just gave birth to our third child yesterday, so I will not be going back to Pringle until tomorrow, but I will get some shots then. Talk to you soon.

Rachel is buried in a little cemetery at the edge of a State Park and army base. It's out in the woods out some old dirt roads somewhere between Atlantic (near Tunnelton) and River Road (between Rowlesburg and Kingwood

Another source (Lucretia Moyer) states:

The grave is located between Rowlesburg and Tunnelton. From Tunnelton out Campground Road, then Blazer

Road, then out Atlantic from there there are a lot of little road you either pass or take and its hard to explain. From River Road (between Kingwood and Rowlesburg) take Pringle Road (This road is sometimes closed for National Guard training.), Stay on the main (I use that term loosely) road. Go past the National Guard training area. At the end of the area there is a fork take the one on the left going up a hill. Rachel's grave is on the left in the woods. Its hard to see from the road. The road is a dead end. She's shortly before the dead end. They are logging in this area.

John FREELAND, farmer, sec. 2; P.O., Millersburg; was born in Preston county, W. Va., Dec. 23, 1812, the son of John and Mary (MCCANN) FREELAND; father a native of Maryland and of English descent, and mother a native of Pennsylvania and of German and Irish descent; educated in the log school-house in Virginia; came to this county in 1835, arriving with only \$2.50 in his purse; obtained a start in life by working out by the month, and lately he has been offered \$14,000 for his farm, which is in the suburbs of Millersburg. He has been prominently identified with the history of this community. In 1837, in Benton, he married Sarah Longacre, and 6 of their 7 children are living; the 3 sons are married. Mrs. F. is not now living. She was a Baptist, as is also her husband.

Notes for Joshua W. HARDESTY:

Joshua HARDESTY died in 1875 at the age of 64. He was a Methodist Minister.

Joshua HARDESTY, when about twenty years old, together with a family of FREELAND, emigrated to the hills of Old Virginia. There he located on the waters of Salt Lick Creek, three miles southwest of Cranberry Summit, which was then a dense forest, but now a prosperous town called Terra Alta, Preston County, Virginia. Here in the wilderNESS he built himself a small shanty and for three years or more lived alone, isolated from civilization, but with that determination to succeed that has always characterized the HARDESTY family. He fought his way through poverty and discouragement until success came. Think of a boy miles from home and friends, among the wild beasts and savages, struggling to be something in life!

At the age of twenty-three, 1834, he married Elizabeth FREELAND, the only daughter of John FREELAND, who had emigrated and settled three miles East of her father on the same creek. For nearly fifty years they toiled and labored together in this wilderNESS. Their sacrifices were beyond description. For four years they had no horse to till the ground or carry the corn to the mill. Father was the horse. We can see him with a sack of corn on his back following the Indian Trail over the mountains, a distance of ten miles, to the mill known as the Billy ASHBY Mill, which was named after its owner, who had emigrated years before and located on the south prong of Snowy Creek, which was situated in GARRETT County, Maryland. This mill was operated by Joshua HARDESTY, who had also emigrated from Pennsylvania. Here he lost his wife and married Betty ASHBY, sister of Billy ASHBY.

Unable to adequately provide for their large family on the small farm in Washington Co., Albert and Ruth moved to Colorado to a land claim 5 1/2 miles from the small town of Willard, CO. Albert, like his brother-in-law, had been a coal miner but decided to take advantage of the government offer to settle the sparse acres of Colorado and Montana.

Albert, a hard luck gold miner, tried several times to lease his own mine but always failed to strike any prosperous veins. Ruth struggled on the homestead with the family. The homestead proved up in 1914. (Not sure if this is correct, as the handwriting is hard to decipher at times.) In 1916, Albert gave up mining and turned to homesteading. In 1919, when Forrest was eleven, the family moved into Willard and farmed on the outside of town.

With the end of WWI, the family prospered, but lost their entire fortune when the depression struck in 1929. Albert returned to Cripple Creek to mine and Ruth moved to South Dakota and lived in a small house with their three youngest children, Forrest, Faymie and James. She was on a property owned by her brother Charlie COOPER while her family attended school. Hard times had become a way of life for her. (From the handwritten notes of Mamie Seward SNIDER, dated January 27, 1978)
