for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars, to the said Tarr & wife in hand paid, the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged said parties of the first part doth promise and agree to sell and deliver and have this day delivered unto the said Mary Barnes, in pursuance of said Sale, all the personal property contained in the hotel of the said George F. Tarr, in said Borough known as the "Union Hotel" situate on the Western Penna. R.R. consisting of Breakfasts, Bedding, Carpets, chairs, Bureaus, Stoves, Parapetans, Cupboard ware, Kitchen ware, &c saving and excepting the wearing apparel of the said Geo. F. Tarr and Susannah his wife, and also the Breakfast and bedding not exceeding two in number of which are truly designated as being those in the private Room of said Geo. F. Tarr & wife now occupied as their family room. And it is further agreed, that the said Mary Barnes shall and by these presents doth let and hire unto the said Susannah Tarr, wife of the said Geo. F. Tarr, all the above mentioned personal property for and during the term of two years from this date, at the annual rent of twenty four dollars, which has this day been paid for said term.
