Last Will and Testament.

I, Robert F. Tarr,
of Kittanning Borough, County of Armstrong,
and State of Pennsylvania, being of sound mind and memory, do hereby make,
publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, hereby
revoking any will or wills heretofore made by me.

First. I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be fully paid and satisfied, as soon
as conveniently may be, after my decease. Said funeral expenses, including a
small marker, not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars.

Second. I give and bequeath to my sister, Josephine, intermarried
with Charles Stivenson, and now living at West Brownsville, Pa., the
sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to be paid at the rate of Fifty
Dollars per month.

Third. I give and bequeath to my half-brother, George Thomas Tarr,
now living at Lowellville, Ohio, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)
Dollars, to be paid at the rate of Fifty Dollars per month,

Payment of the aforesaid legacies to begin within three months
after my decease.

Fourth. I give and bequeath to the Watch Tower Bible & Tract
Society of Brooklyn, New York, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)
Dollars.

Fifth. All the rest and remainder of my estate, real and personal,
I give and bequeath to my daughter, Jessie Ruth, intermarried with
Watson Bowser, for and during her natural life, with full power to
dispose of the real and personal estate should it be necessary to do
so to provide for her comfort and support.

Sixth. Upon the death of my said daughter, Jessie Ruth, I direct
that the surviving executor convert all my estate remaining, both real
and personal, into cash, out of which estate I direct my executor to
pay as follows:-

First. The funeral expenses, including a marker for the
grave, of my said daughter.

Second. To pay to my niece, Laura, intermarried with William
Miller, the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, to be paid at the
rate of \$50.00 per month.

Third. To pay to my cousins, Samuel C. Tarr, and Mrs. Ida Tarr Davis, of East Franklin Township, Armstrong County, Pa., in gratitude for favors in the past, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) each, to be paid at the rate of \$50.00 per month.

Fourth. To pay one-third of the estate remaining after providing for the aforesaid legacies, to my sister, Josephine Stivenson, and one-third to my half-brother, George Thomas Tarr, to be paid to them at the rate of \$50.00 per month.

Payment of said legacies to begin within three months after the death of my said daughter.

In case of the death of any of the legatees named in this will before the said bequests have been paid in full, the unpaid part of said legacies is to lapse and fall into my residuary estate.

Fifth. All the rest and remainder of my estate, real and personal or mixed, I give and bequeath to the Watch Tower Bible and Tract Society of Brooklyn, New York.

I do hereby make, constitute and appoint my said daughter, Jessie R. Bowser, and the Armstrong County Trust Company of Kittanning, Pa., to be Executors of this my Last Will and Testament.
