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Fredrick Varner Know all men by these presents that Fredrick Varner of the county of
 Westmoreland and state of Pennsylvania for and in consideration of
 Christopher Hays the sum of Eighteen Pounds good and lawful money of Pennsylvania
 to me in hand paid by Christopher Hays of the county and state
 of said the receipt whereof the said Fredrick Varner hath truly acknowledge
 hath granted and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and
 sell unto the said Christopher Hays all my right title interest claim and de-
 mand of in and to a certain application and order of survey returned in the
 land office of Pennsylvania for 300 acres of land Pt 667. bearing date April 3^d
 1769 the same order of survey obtained for a tract of land situate in
 Westmoreland county in Pennsylvania including his improvement or open-
 ings joining the claims of Joseph Bulow & being the same tract of land con-
 veyed to the said Christopher Hays by the said Fredrick Varner by a bill
 of sale bearing date the fifteenth day of July 1768 and also all my right title
 interest claim and demand of in and to the same order of Survey & hold
 the above mentioned order of survey with all the rights unto the said Christopher
 Hays his heirs and assigns forever witnesses whereof the said Fredrick Varner hath
 hereunto set his hand and seal this first day of December 1786.

John Altman This Indenture made this twentieth day of December in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and six between John Altman and
 Great Gracie Margaret his wife of Hempfield township and state of Pennsylvania
 of the one part and Great Gracie of the township and county & state a-
 fore said of the other part Whereas the unmarried of Pennsylvania by patent bear-
 ing date the 21st day of April 1786 was granted unto Great Kimmel a tract of land
 called Request involved in the Hill Office for the state of Pennsylvania in patent
 book No 6 page 246 which the said Great Kimmel and Sarah Margaret his wife
 conveyed the same to Andrew Kimmel for the consideration therein men-
 tioned bearing date the 28th day of June 1796 and the said Andrew Kimmel and
 Elizabeth his wife conveyed the same by deed to George Mayer bearing date
 the 11th day of February 1801 reference to the respective titles will more fully and ac-
 curately appear than this Indenture Witnesseth that the said John Altman and Mar-
 garet his wife for and in consideration of five hundred Dollars to
 them in hand paid at and before the executing and delivery thereof by the
 said Great Gracie have granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth
 bargain and sell unto the said Great Gracie his heirs and assigns all the following
 described part or parcel of the above described tract of (Part) Beginning at a point
 along said Mayer's land to a point thence south forty perches to a white oak thence
 South fifty degrees East one hundred and eight perches to another oak by land of
 Tobias Painter thence North fifty seven degrees East one hundred and twelve
