

## **Mrs. J. K. Ramsauer Buried Here Saturday**

**Mrs. J. K. Ramsauer, 76, died at the home of her deceased brother, H. W. Kingsbery, early last Friday morning, and was buried in the local cemetery Saturday evening.**

**She was preceded in death by her brother just one week.**

**Mrs. Ramsauer came to Santa Anna from the State of Georgia some eighteen years ago, and live in Santa Anna for a period of ten or eleven years, during with time she endeared herself to a large circle of friends. She was said to be active in church and community work devoted much of her time to others. She moved from here to Austin seven years ago, where her children would have wider fields of opportunities, and better educational advantages.**
