

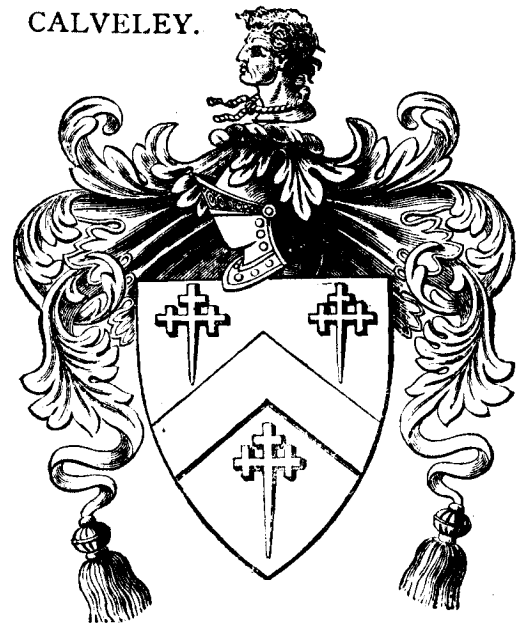
CALVELEY AND DAVENPORT OF CALVELEY.



HUGH DE CALVELEY, lord of Calveley in the reign of king John, by grant from Richard de Vernon.

RICHARD DE CALVELEY, LEUCA, sister confirmed in possession of the same by Elena, daughter of Matthew de Vernon, and Matthew de Alraham, by deeds without date.

WILLIAM DE CALVELEGH, younger son of Richard de Calvelegh.
 ROBERT DE CALVELEGH, father of Richard, who releases lands to Richard de Calvelegh, by deed without date.
 HUGH DE CALVELEGH, son and heir, by deeds of Leuca de Calvelegh, without date.
 ALICIA, daughter of [qy. a widow 7 & 13 Edw. 2.]



ALICIA, daughter and heiress, 14 Edw. 3, wife of Nicholas de Wetenal, 21 Edw. 3.

KENRIC DE CALVYLEGH, [lord of Calvylegh,] son and heir, by deed without date, [living 14-15 Edw. 3, ob. ante 28 Edw. 3.]

MATILDA, daughter of living as wife of Kenric de Calvelegh, 3 Edw. 3.

JOHN DE CALVELEGH [of Caldey, 5, 13, &] 16 Edw. 2, 9 & 11 Edw. 3.
 PETER DE CALVELEGH, 1 Edw. 3. [on the king's service in Brittany, 22 Edw. 3.]

RICHARD WILLIAM DAVID, [7 Edw. 2, held land in Calvylegh.]

ALICIA, grantee of lands from her brother John, 3 Edw. 3.

HENRY DE CALVYLEGH, [lands in Calvylegh,] of his father.

THOMAS DE CALVYLEGH, remainderman in tail of lands in Calvylegh, died between 21 and 27 Edw. 3.

ISABEL, daughter and coheir of Roger de Pennesby, joint lord of Thyngwall.]

ROBERT DE CALVYLEGH, [lord of Calvylegh,] son and heir, by deeds without date, [living 3 Edw. 3,] obit ante 1350.

[ELIZABETH,] daughter and coheir of Ralph, son of David de Haselwall. A widow in 1350.

JOHANNA, daughter of mother of Hugh, son of David Calvelegh, by deed 29 Edw. 3. First wife.

DAVID DE CALVELEGH, 2d son, of Lea in the hundred of Broxton, as by Inq. p. m. 35 Edw. 3.

MABELLA, daughter of [living 16 Edw. 2,] Inq. p. m. 35 Edw. 3.

ROGER, held lands in Calvelegh, Inq. 27 Edw. 3, a. s. p. WILLIAM, brother and heir to Roger of Thyngwall, a son on his father's death, o. s. p.

ROBERT DE CALVYLEGH, brother and heir to William, a minor, qy. o. s. p.]

[ELEN, daughter of Robert, and sister and coheir of Ralph de Calvylegh; a minor, 25 Edw. 3, qy. wife of this Robert. Inq. 35 Edw. 3. o. s. p.]

ARTHUR DE DAVENPORT, 6th son of sir John Davenport, of Davenport, kt. by Margery, daughter of sir W. Brereton, kt. slain at the battle of Shrewsbury, 1403. [Inq. p. m. 4 Hen. 4.]

KATHERINE, sister and coheir [of [Ralph] de Calvelegh, married ante 1369, living a widow 1405, married [ante 26 Edw. 3,] first to [Thomas] de Beston, who died before 35 Edw. 3.

[RALPH,] de Calvelegh, [lord of Calvelegh, son and heir,] obit [circ. 27] Edw. 3. s. p.

Sir HUGH CALVELEY of Lea, kt. son and heir, founder of the College of Bunbury; died seized of the manor of Lea, on the feast of St. George, 1393. Inq. p. m. 17 Ric. 2. s. p.

DAVID DE CALVELEY, second son, died before his brother, releases lands in Calveley to Thomas Minshull, 1361. Seal without the fesse.

AGNES, daughter and heiress of Mottram, held one third of Mottram Andrew in dower, as per Inq. Ric. 2.
 ROBERT CALVELEY, 3d son, 49 Edw. 3, [qy. husband of Elen, sister of Ralph de Calvelegh.] RICHARD CALVELEY, 4th son, 49 Edw. 3.

MARGARET, o. s. p. Inq. p. m. 14 Hen. 6. [see Clotton Hulfield.]

HENRY DAVENPORT, [lord] of Calveley, son and heir. [Ob. and] Inq. p. m. 31 Hen. 6.

ISABELLA, daughter of living 18 Ric. 2.

[qy. AGNES,] daughter and heiress of Handford of Handford.

Sir HUGH CALVELEY, the younger, kt. of Lea and Mottram, died on Monday after the feast of Pope St. Leo. Inq. p. m. 17 Ric. 2.

[RICHARD] DAVENPORT of Calveley, died in the time of his father, ante 12 Hen.

MARGARET, daughter of Thos. Davenport, of Betchton, living a widow, 12 Hen. 6.

Sir DAVID DE CALVELEY, kt. son and heir, [and heir to his grand-uncle,] ret. 7, 17 Ric. 2,] o. s. p. Inq. p. m. 9 Hen. 4.

HUGH CALVELEY, esq. brother and heir. Inq. p. m. 11 Hen. 6. Ancestor of the Calveleys of Lea.

ALICE. MARGARET, wife of sir John Delves of Delves hall, sher. co. Staff. 14 Ric. 2.

Sir JOHN CALVELEY, grantee of the manor of Shotwick from Ric. 2, [ob. ante 6 Hen. 4, Juliana, his widow, then living.]

HUGH DAVENPORT of Calveley, esq. heir to his grandfather, [ret. 30, 31 Hen. 6, ob. 9 Edw. 4.] Inq. p. m. 11 Edw. 4., daughter and heiress of William Handford of Handford.

RALPH DAVENPORT of Calveley, esq. son and heir, [ret. 24, 11 Edw. 4,] died on Whitsunday, 14 Hen. 8. Inq. p. m. 14 Hen. 8. ISABELLA, daughter of [Richard] Spurstowe of Spurstowe, esq. married 9 Edw. 4. Harl. MSS. 2119.
