ARMS. *Argent (ar) a chevron between three cross-crosets fitchée sable (s) [DAVENPORT]; impaling [gules] a lion rampant, double queued, [argent], ducally crowned (or), between three crescents [of the last] [SALUSBURY.]*

CREST. *A felon's head, coupéd at the shoulders [proper], around the neck a rope (or).*

NB: Ralph DAVENPORT was Mayor of Chester on three occasions:
1489/90, 1493/94 & 1501/02.

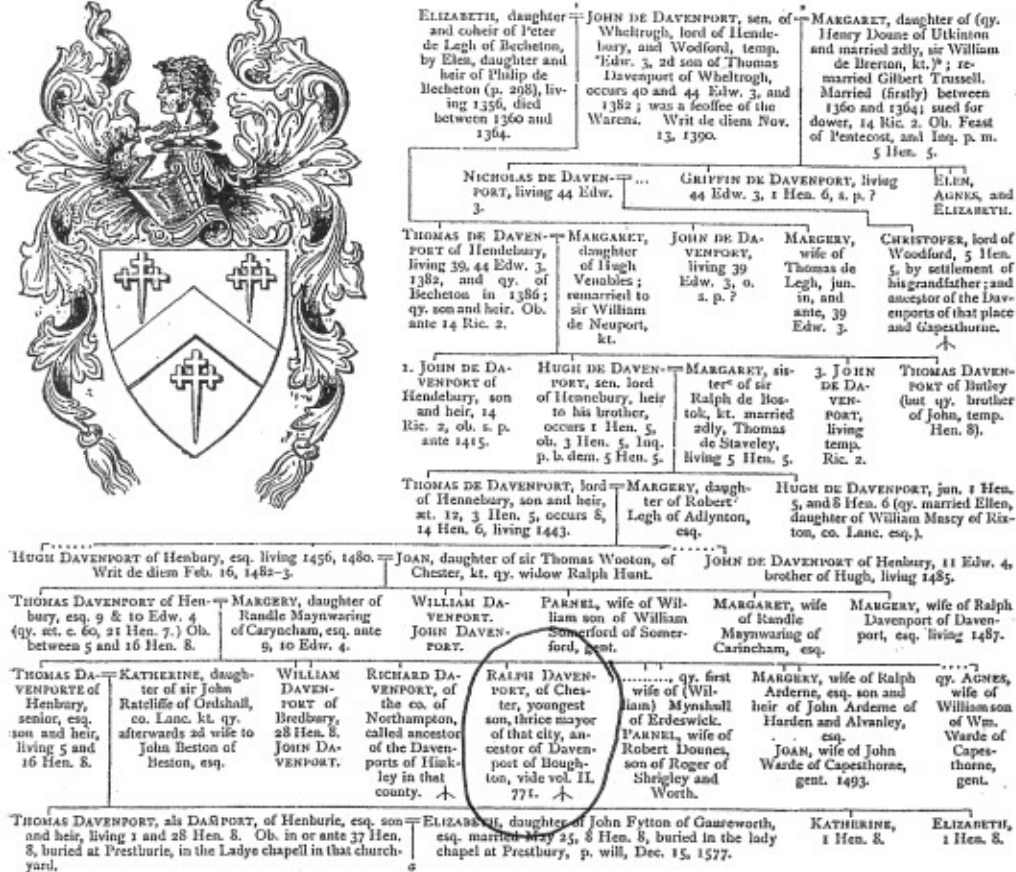
