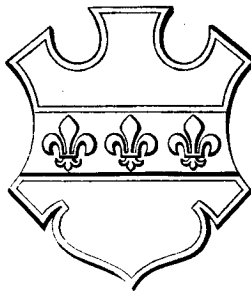

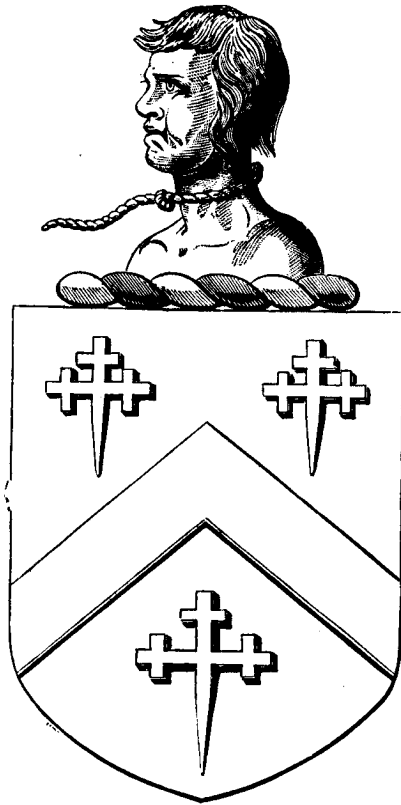

ARMS.—*Argent, a chevron between three crosslets fitché sable.*

CREST.—*A man's head in dexter profile, couped at the shoulders, his neck entwined with a rope proper.*
