The item below is riddled with maybes which will have to be proven as we go down the road. I believe most of them are good guesses, but as yet they are but guesses. From James of Lancaster on down are names which appeared on the genealogy of Wilber Lee Clingan of California. so it is quite firm from there on down.

The James Clingan family of Richland County Ohio is the only Clingan family in that area as far as I can tell. It is comparitvly easy to place a new name in the proper family simply by comparing ages. Even so there is the possibility of error and I urge each researcher to use his own wit concerning each and every name.

The papers from Wilbur Lee Clingan and the ones from Nansy Bier seem to be trying to make the James of Lancaster Co PA out to be the James Clingan of Richland County Ohio. However, the dates are all wrong. James of Lancaster was married to Elizabeth Stauffer before 1782, while the record shows James of Richland to be born in 1778 . This may allow a father son relation ship. However, I do believe that the Richland County James was

the ancestor of Wilbur. One of Nancy's papers suggested that he may have been the first son of George Clingan, son of William Clingan Jr. Son of Thomas of Lancaster County PA. The paper says George moved to the west and came first to Ohio. This awaits further proof.

I believe it is very possible that James of Lancaster was one of the five Clingan brothers, although I find it hard to believe he was not mentioned in any of the brothers wills. One explanation may be that he moved to the west and lost contact with the brothers.

James Clingan b.c.1734, married Elizabeth Stauffer at Lancaster PA sometime before c.1782, according to family search .com.it was 1756, but Elizabeth had children by one Abraham Hackman, the younger of the ten being born in 1775.

The papers I have found on the Stauffer family history states James Clingan was her second husband and was married by (I take that to mean before)c.1782. There are some who feel that James of Richland Co Ohio may be the son of James of Lancaster Co PA and he may well be. The date of their wedding (if we take the middle ground) and the date of James birth would seem to fit that scenario. He was born in 1778 making it possible that Elizabeth may have been his mother.

In Wilbur Clingan's family genealogy papers there was a John listed born 1782 who was possibly a brother of James of Richland Co. I am going to list it this way as we await further thrust on the information hotline.

The fact that he was a native of Holland. Apparently his

parents moved to Ireland when he was young rules since all the evidence we have concerning him states he came from Ireland. I include the article from the net:

### Robert T. Clingan

Clingan Robert T., who is successfully engaged in farming in Scotland TWP, McDonough County, IL, was born in n Woodsville Ohio, April 25,1883, the son of Geopge B. and Catherine (Sabin-Amos) Clingan. His father was born in Woodsfield Ohio and his mother in Lebonon NY. On the paternal side, his grandfather, Robert Clingan, was a native of Belmont County, Ohio and his grandmother, Elizabeth(Van Horn) Clingan of Philadelphia PA. The Van Horn branch of the family being Hollanders. His great grandfather, John Clingan, was also a native of Holland, and his great grandmother, Mary E.(Armstrong) Clingan was a native of Ireland. On the maternal side, Robert T's. grandparents,Chester and Caroline(Thayer) Sabin, were natives of Lebonon NY. The Maternal great grandparents,Nathaniel and Margaret(Rhinedollar)Sabin, were natives of Philadelphia PA.

Elisabeth(Van Horn( Clingan came from PA to Ohio when she was seventeen years old. Her union with Robert T. Clingan's grandfather resulted in six children of whom George B. Clingan was the eldest, the others being girls. At age twenty one, George B. began to work for himself, being formerly employed on a farm and in a grist mill. In 1886, he came to Macomb and bought a farm of 156 acres and there Robert T. received a common school education.....

I found a record of a John Clingan ministering in Springfield Ohio in 1910 and later on as a pastor in 1812-1813. He was officially accepted as a member of the Methodist-Episcopal Association in 1813. I also found where he worked at starting a church in Delaware County Ohio, where his ties with the Delaware County family apparently had its roots. He appears to have spent the remainder of his life in Belmont and Monroe Counties of Ohio. There he married his wife. The 1820 census shows him living in Monroe County with a wife 26 to 44 and three children 1 to 10. He himself is listed 26 to 44. I found a record of him in Gateway to the West where he purchased some land from William and Elizabeth Morris in 1834. I have found a record of a book found in a razed building where He was registered for the draft for Monroe County from 1835 to 1844.

This was William Clingan at the first meeting of the Congress. The fact that there was a Clingan and a Searle present may be good evidence that James at one time lived in The Lancaster area of Pennsylvania, at least it shows that the families were connected. However, we have no clue as what James' relationship was to William and other Lancaster Co PA Clingans. I believe it also shows us that James of Richland County was not born in Ireland as the tradition says, but was in fact born in Pennsylvania.

One thing further I discovered in the Tax listings of Mercer County PA that in 1802 there was a James Clingan and a James Clingan Jr. paying taxes in Neshanock TWP, along with a Joseph and a William Clingan in 1801 and 02. It is possible that this is James, husband of Elizabeth Stauffer, and our James of Richland County.

It is probable that the above scenario is incorrect since I found on the family search the James married a Mary (last name not given) and started having children in 1794. A list of the children is as follows:

I first found Huett's family in Benton County, 1860 census. He was 39 and Caroline was 29. He was apparently a practicing Physician. According to the report of his descendents, Huett and his son Charles Edward practiced medicine in Benton County IA. In 1877 they moved to Sioux City IA. Huett's brother William A. Clingan, a druggist, also moved to Iowa from NE. Harry Clingan, son of Charles E. graduated from dental School in Denver CO, 1904 and moved to Sundance Wyoming in 1911 to become a rancher.

A news item taken from m the net will interest you:  
**A FORMER RICHLAND COUNTY MAN MURDERED  
IN IOWA.**

A few days since Mr. Thomas Clingan, of Weller Township, recieved a dispatch from Polk City, IA stating that his brother had been shot on the evening of July 10(1883), while on his way home from his store to his house. Robert Clingan, the murder man, was formerly a resident of Weller Township, and some years ago moved to Iowa.

An Associated Press dispatch from Des Moines, Iowa dated July 13th, says: a dispatch from Marnes Station on the Rock Island Road, in Cass County, says Clingan Murderers were surrounded ina grove eight miles north of that town this afternoon, and in an effort to dislodge them from their hiding places, a man named Frank Hollock, from Exira was fatally shot.

Great excitment prevails throughout this part of the state. Three hundred or more men surround the grove where the murderers are concealed, and there is no doubt that they will be captured.

A second dispatch from the same place on July 14, says: The murderers of Clingan at Polk City, last Tuesday night, were overtaken and surrounded in a large body of timber known as Bikhorn Grove, in the southeast corner ofShelby County, last night, and this morning attemped an escape. One of them was fatally wounded, the other was captured. The wounded man gave the name of Benjamin Gates, and before he died confessed that he was the murderer of

Clingan. The other man was threatened with hanging and also confessed.

In the fight preceding, the capture, J.W.Maddy, a druggist of Maroe, was fatally shot and it is thought he will die. Benjamin Craig, a farmer, was also shot, though not fatally. The captured man gave the name of Smith, from Missouri, and is in jail in Harlan, Shelby County.....there is intense excitement in Halan, and probably Smith will be lynched before morning.
